Caretel Inns of Linden Sub-acute Rehabilitation Program

Caretel Inns of Linden Sub-Acute Rehabilitation Program is an individualized combination of medical and therapeutic techniques provided by the Medical Director, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation physician, physician assistant and the professional rehabilitation/nursing staff.

Throughout the guest’s stay in the Program, the physicians and physician assistant; nursing staff; occupational and physical therapist; speech pathologist and mental health specialist (if needed), and social worker work closely together to facilitate rehabilitation so as to promote optimum independence and well-being.

The rehabilitation team determines the length of stay based upon resident progress and medical necessity.

Purposes of the Program

- To provide medical and rehabilitation management of the resident through the collaborative efforts of the team.
- To provide an individualized plan of treatment designed to maximize the resident’s abilities.
- To facilitate discharge planning by providing information and/or making the necessary referrals regarding
- Community resources that are available to the resident and family.
